



Damage Deposit Scheme

The amount of Damage Deposit is £250 per club, or for U15 & U16 teams the damage deposit amount is £500.00.

This amount MUST BE paid via our website by using the normal LOGIN at: http://www.footballtournaments.co.uk/manage-my-booking then selecting the tab "Payments"

Enter your debit or credit card details and the applicable amount (the sum of either £250 or £500) will automatically be deducted from your invoice. Please note we **WILL NOT** accept cheques for this amount. We do not debit the card used at this point - it is used as a guarantee until such a time as a payment was required due to damage caused (see notes 1 to 5 below).

The damage deposit payment must be entered onto your booking prior to your team players being entered.

- 1. At least 4 weeks prior to departure we require you to nominate a credit/debit card, which may be debited for an amount not exceeding £250 or £500 for U15 & U16 teams. The nominated credit card will only be debited (up to the limit specified) in the event of damage and/or loss being reported and substantiated to us by the Holiday Park concerned within three weeks of your return. The nominated card may also be debited (up to the limit of £250/£500.00) in respect of any outstanding balances payable for your tour, which remain outstanding on your return.
- 2. Should it be the case that damage and/or loss is discovered or reported either during the course of the tour or immediately following your departure, R & T Tours will debit the nominated credit card for the estimated costs of repair or loss up to a maximum of £250/£500*. Where the cost of repairing the damage and/or replacing the stolen items and/or the balance outstanding in respect of the tour exceeds £250/£500*, you will be invoiced in respect of the balance payable and would be expected to pay the amount requested within 7 days of receipt of the invoice.
- 3. If no such report of pre-existing damage or shortages is made to the Holiday Park on arrival, we will assume that no such pre-existing damage or shortages existed.
- 4. The imposition of the loss of the Damage Deposit can and will extend to damage and/or loss caused on the coach, ferry or any other form of transport used and/or public or private property, which can be attributed to the individual/s concerned.
- Any incidence of malicious damage, vandalism and/or theft will also be reported to the Police Authorities for the appropriate action to be taken against the individual/s concerned. We will ALSO submit a detailed report of any incidence, on or off the pitch, to the appropriate league Secretary.
